The grant may expand book collections, replace old books, or fund literary causes. Minimum grants will be \$500 and maximum grants will be \$2,000 per application approved. The application deadline is WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 8, 2010. The Committee reserves the right to award amounts at its discretion within these guidelines. Since the inception of the Book Fair in 1981, over \$300,000 has been awarded to Kentucky libraries.

Each year approximately 200 authors are present to autograph copies of their latest books. Our 29-year history shows that as many as 5,000 patrons attend annually and purchase over \$100,000 in gross sales. For further information, check out: <http://kybookfair.org/>.
